AIR FRANCE AND KLM INCREASE FUEL SURCHARGE

Due to the extremely high oil prices, **Air France** is increasing its fuel surcharge by 1 euro on domestic flights, 2 euros on medium-haul flights and 7 euros on long-haul flights.

Valid on tickets issued in France as from 10 August 2006, these increase will be withdrawn as soon as the price of the barrel drops below 65 dollars for 30 consecutive days.

KLM Royal Dutch Airlines will increase its fuel surcharge by 5 euros per stretch on all intercontinental flights and by 1 euro per stretch on all intra European flights.

This increase will be imposed on tickets issued as of 10 August 2006 and will be withdrawn as soon as the barrel price will have dropped below 70 dollars for more than 30 consecutive days.
