AIR FRANCE AND KLM INCREASE FUEL SURCHARGE

Due to the very high price of fuel, the group will be increasing its fuel surcharge from 19 July 2005. Air France and KLM will increase their fuel surcharge in order to obtain comparable levels. The effectiveness of its fuel hedges will, however, enable the Group to limit this increase.

These surcharges will be withdrawn as soon as the price of the barrel goes below 50 dollars for 30 consecutive days.

Air France will increase its fuel surcharge by 1 euro on domestic routes, 2 euros on medium-haul routes and 4 euros on long-haul routes. This increase will be added on the tickets issued in France.

KLM Royal Dutch Airlines will increase its fuel surcharge by 14 euros per stretch on all long-haul flights.
