AIR FRANCE AND KLM INCREASE FUEL SURCHARGE

In response to the very high level of fuel prices, **Air France** is increasing its fuel surcharge by 1 euro on French domestic flights, by 2 euros on medium-haul flights and by 8 euros on long-haul flights. This increase, valid on tickets issued in France as from 20 April 2005, will be withdrawn as soon as the price of the barrel goes below 45 dollars for 30 consecutive days.

KLM Royal Dutch Airlines will increase its fuel surcharge by 6 euros per stretch on long-haul flights and 3 euros per stretch on European flights.

This increase, imposed on tickets issued as of April 15, 2005, will be withdrawn as soon as the barrel price drops below 45 dollars for 30 consecutive days.
